## President's Letter



I am Tlingit, My name is Jacob KM Cabuag Jr., My given Tlingit name is “Shaa-klaa-nay”. Eagle (Ch'aak) - Moiety, Killer Whale (Naanyaa.aayi) – Clan, of Wrangell.

Tlingit and Haida Tribal Citizens and Alaska Native Relatives,

Our 74<sup>th</sup> Annual Tribal Assembly is in the record books and details can be seen at this web link: <http://www.ccthita.org/2009TribalAssembly.html>

During this assembly it was apparent that the economy was, and still is, a factor in the financial and future directions of Central Council. The cost of energy in our villages in

Southeast Alaska seems to be unchanged and continues to lay a burden on the cost of living for our family members and relatives. Compared to our 7 to 8 cents per kwh we have here in the Seattle area; in Southeast it's quite a lot higher and in some villages it's 64 to 68 cents per kwh. The development of our Energy Department is moving forward to secure funding for projects within the Southeast Alaska villages. There was good discussion on the floor during the adoption of the 2009 and 2010 budgets that will assist in this direction. We will need to keep in mind that some of the activities in the Energy Dept. comes with a cost to Central Council's general account budget and we will need to weigh that against the needs of our people.

Current developments in progress are a Memorandum Of Agreement to joint venture business opportunities between Central Council and Sealaska, a historical partnership; also the development of “For Profit” business ventures for Central Council. This will strengthen our financial standing, expand our opportunities for building unregulated revenue which will be used specifically for the betterment of our Tribal Citizens.

As you will read in our committee reports, we are gearing up for our summer activities. Seattle Community Council Picnic and Culture Fair. Quite the undertaking: family and friends with the artists, language classes, carving and weaving classes, not to mention the food and games makes for great atmosphere throughout these events. We have great committees that work very hard to put these events together. We can always use help and new committee members. Come to the meetings and get involved, the first Thursday of the month at 606 12<sup>th</sup> Ave. S. Seattle, WA 98144. Meetings are 6:30pm to 8:30pm. It's your organization, please join us, we hope to see you there!

## Seventy Fourth CCTHITA Tribal Assembly Reports

### Judiciary Committee — Lowell K Halverson

The Judiciary Committee is a Standing Committee that reports directly to the Tribal Assembly. Its tasks are to promote the tribe's sovereignty, support its courts' operations and provide expertise in furtherance of the Assembly's legislative functions. Over the years, the Judiciary Committee has participated in the drafting of most of the tribe's statutes and amendments to the Constitution. It works directly with the tribe's social service agencies and participates in negotiations with state and federal agencies on legal issues affecting the tribe's sovereignty. When the tribe received federal funds to operate its own Child Support Enforcement program in 2007, the state of Alaska refused to acknowledge the tribe's child support orders in state courts, claiming that there was no "Indian country" in Alaska.

In the following two years, the Judiciary Committee participated in direct negotiations with the state's Attorney General while pressuring the federal government to intervene, either through federal mediators or by issuance of a non-compliance letter. Federal law requires that states cooperate with tribes on a government to government basis on matters affecting enforcement of child support orders. That has not happened. Recently, the federal government issued a non-compliance letter to the State of Alaska, threatening to withdraw federal funds for the state's programs. According to **Bob Loescher**, whose Judiciary Sub-committee heavily lobbied the legislature, the amount at stake was over 100 million dollars. Happily, the Alaska Legislature passed Senate Bill 96, which amended the definition of state" to include an "Indian Tribe" in the Uniform Interstate Family Support Act (UIFSA). Negotiations will continue with the Attorney General to implement the "intergovernmental" relationship between the two child support programs. Although the statute suggests that the state will remain "neutral" on jurisdictional issues,

the devil is in the details, so to speak. Beginning July 1, 2009 if the State of Alaska fails to recognize the orders and administrative actions produced by Central Council's Tribal Court and Tribal Child Support Unit (TCSC), the Judiciary Committee is expected to move swiftly. It's been two years too long, already.

During Tribal Assembly, the Judiciary Committee presented a motion to amend four Resolutions which the Executive Council had passed during the month preceding the Assembly. In effect, these Executive Council resolutions nullified several statutes passed by the Tribal Assembly in 2007. The Judiciary Committee expressed concern that the political autonomy of the Tribal Assembly was being eroded by the effect of these Resolutions. Specifically, the President was granted unlimited political authority to appoint or remove any member of the Judiciary Committee and the Finance Committee at any time, not just every two years. There was spirited debate followed by a roll call vote 54-46 against the motion. The Judiciary Committee will likely revisit this topic during the coming year, depending on who the President reappoints to this Standing Committee this year.

#### Indian Tribes' Child Support Legislation Enacted

While delegates gathered in Juneau for the 74th annual Tribal Assembly April 15-18, a victory for Alaska tribes was achieved and announced on the floor of the assembly that the Alaska Legislature passed Senate Bill 96, which amended the definition of "state" to include an "Indian Tribe" in the Uniform Interstate Family Support Act (UIFSA). The statutory clarification was sought by the Central Council of the Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Central Council) to gain the necessary state recognition of Central Council's Tribal Court and child support orders. This triumph for all Alaska tribes was accomplished with the assistance of Central Council President **Bill Martin**, the Governor's Office, and through the diligence and determination of Delegate and Judiciary Sub-committee member **Bob Loescher**, Tribal Attorney **Jessie Archibald**, and Tribal Child Support Unit (TCSU) Manager **Eddie Brakes**" with support from the Judiciary Committee and the judges. "During

the legislative session, Loescher, Archibald, and Brakes worked on a “government-to-government” basis to move the legislation through the House and Senate with the assistance of Senator **Bettye Davis**, Senator **Albert Kookesh**, Representative **Bill Thomas**, and members of the Alaska Bush Caucus.

In 1993, the National Uniform Law Commission approved the UIFSA and recommended that it be adopted by all states. Section 466(f) of the Social Security Act requires all states to adopt UIFSA as a condition of receiving federal funding for the state operation of child support services. The underlying premise of UIFSA is to increase cooperation between jurisdictions and encourage jurisdictions to have respect and tolerance for the laws of other states and nations in order to facilitate child support enforcement. When Alaska adopted the UIFSA in 1995, legislators omitted the words “Indian Tribe” from the definition of “state” and it has stood as the only state to make this deliberate exclusion. . .

#### **Judiciary Committee — Mary L. Lekanof**

I have been serving as a standing member of the Judiciary Committee for the last eight years and would like to report that we had a very busy schedule during the recent Tribal Assembly. The Judiciary Committee has been working with Eddie Brakes, Tribal Child Support Unit (TCSU) Manager, as well as the Tribal Court Office to establish the first Tribal Court System of the Central Council of the Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (CCTHITA). As a Standing Committee, the Judiciary Committee is authorized to meet 2-3 times a year on an “as needed” basis. Proposed amendments to the CCTHITA Constitution and Bylaws were reviewed and amended before being forwarded to other committees for their review and action. All of the Statutes to establish the CCTHITA Tribal Court were also reviewed and amended before presentation before various Tribal Assemblies over the years beginning at the Sitka Tribal Assembly.

#### **Audit Committee — Jania Garcia**

The Audit committee is a Standing Committee that advises the Executive Council and the President on audit, accountability, and compliance matters. The committee met April 6, 2009 to review the 2008 Audit Reports prepared by Elgee Rehfeld Mertz, LLC. Central Council is still in negotiations with

the National Business Center for the 2008 indirect cost rates and anticipates an increase in those rates. The 2007 indirect cost rates were applied to the 2008 financial statements. Pending settlement of this matter, the committee recommended that the 2008 financial statements be presented in draft form to the Tribal Assembly and that they be finalized after the issuance and application of the 2008 rates. The Audit Committee report was adopted April 16, 2009.

#### **Election Committee — Jan Peele**

I am still the Chair on the Election Committee and on the ballot this year was TRIBAL JUDGE and DELEGATE/CITIZEN OF THE YEAR. I am happy to report that **Charlene Wolf** of Craig has been re-elected as Tribal Judge. And I am very happy to announce that Seattle’s very own **Marian Lauth** was voted as the Delegate of the Year! Congrats to both.

#### **Delegate of the Year Marian Lauth**

Seattle Delegate Marian Lauth was elected Delegate of the Year at the 2009 Tlingit & Haida Tribal Assembly in Juneau. We are so proud that our nominee was elected and will receive a trip to Anchorage in the fall to attend the Alaska Federation of Natives Convention. Marian is Tlingit, Raven moiety, Strong Man Clan. She was born in Klawock to **Thompson Peratrovich** and **Audrey Rowan**. Marian has served for 23 years as a delegate to the Tribal Assembly. She has served our local community by planning and providing good food at many native events over the years. She is currently the Head Start Nutrition Manager at Daybreak Star. Marian was a drummer for Haida Heritage and is now the lead drummer for Haida Lass. She is a recipient of an Elizabeth Peratrovich recognition award. Marian is married to **Fred Lauth**. They have three children — **Fred Jr.** of Juneau, **Karen Elliott**, who works for United Indians of All Tribes, **Carol** who just completed an accounting degree from the University of Alaska — and ten grandchildren. Marion and Fred will celebrate 42 years of marriage in October. Congratulations Marian!



#### **Delegate Report — Marian Lauth**

The 2009 Tribal Assembly was very interesting. I served on the Cultural Heritage Committee and also

on the Election Committee. The Cultural Heritage Committee had only one resolution having to do with the Juneau School District's continued support for the Tlingit Culture Language and Literature program. We passed it. I was excused from the Election Committee because I was a candidate for Delegate of the Year. I thank everyone for nominating and supporting me. Thank you all for the honor.

We were all pretty absorbed by the challenge to the authority of the President to change committee members during the year, especially on the Audit and Judiciary committees. The challenge was whether the Executive Council could make statutory changes and changes to the constitution of the tribe without letting the delegates vote on it.

#### **Delegate Report — Rene Tillman**

Financial Reports covering the 2008, 2009 and 2010 budgets, the status of the Trust Funds and the shortfalls on various programs especially in regard to indirect costs received great attention from delegates at the 2009 Assembly in Juneau. **Corrine Garza**, Chief Operating Officer presented an overview of the fund performances and investment actions taken by Executive Council in the past year. By December 31, 2008 our Trust Fund balance had dropped from \$12.3 million to \$6.3 million or a 42% loss. In December the Executive Council notified Ferrel, an investment firm located in Seattle, that the tribe was terminating its arrangement with them. The Investment Committee then reviewed 10 proposals for an investment management consultant and selected Alaska Permanent Capital Management. Investment policy changes were approved including revising the investment goal of building the Trust Fund to \$25 million by 2017 to protecting the principal with sufficient return to cover normal deficits. Once the following investment instruments are sold they will be dropped from our portfolio: Hedge funds, Commodities and Auction Rate Securities.

**Randy Wanamaker**, Chair of the Finance Committee, presented the budgets which included a shortfall of \$234,323 for 2008. Funds to cover this deficit will come from the Trust Fund. There is a projected shortfall of \$187,615 for 2009. What ensued were many delegate questions and suggestions for cutting various budgeted items including management costs and, after study, elimination of some total programs or services. The Energy Program was established by a 2007

resolution. It was proposed that the total Energy program be cut effective April 24. Representatives from various small communities gave impassioned speeches in support of continuing the program until additional funding can be secured. A motion was approved that funding totaling \$80,000+ would continue for an additional three months in an attempt to give the Energy Program time to find other funding sources.

#### **Delegate Report — LaVerne Wise**

Preparation for this year's Tribal Assembly was very difficult. This was the year we had hoped to welcome the Tribal Assembly to Seattle. Because of all of the financial difficulties, we were informed it would be less expensive to hold the Assembly in Juneau. The Saturday before departing for Juneau, I received a call that our beloved, dedicated, and hard working Delegate, **Sue Clark** had 'Walked into the Forest' that morning. Still in shock, we made our way to Juneau.

The highlight of the Assembly was the election of **Marian Lauth** as Delegate of the Year. Marian too works very hard for our Community and really deserves this honor! If all of the Delegates worked as hard as Sue and Marian, we would make headlines all over the place. It is my feeling that if a Delegate is elected by you, then the Delegate should work for you by attending meetings and participating in all of the events put on for you by the Council. Instead, we have to re-introduce ourselves to some of your elected Delegates.

As a member of the Judiciary Committee we met many times working out details for the Tribal Court. Many items are in place for the Court; many are yet to be accomplished. Until our Tribal Court receives the respect of the State of Alaska our court system will not be whole: it is very near. I am also a member of the Enrollment Committee. Our Chairman, **David Leask**, explained the few changes in the committee so long meetings were not necessary. Because of my involvement with the Judiciary Committee, I was unable to attend the Health & Human Services meeting.

#### **Raffle Report — Roger Wise**

We made \$2219 on the Tribal Assembly Raffle. The proceeds were split between the General Fund and Culture Fair accounts: \$1109.50 each. Sandra Cross won the first prize Alaska Airlines tickets. Thank you, Gunalchéesh, Háw'aa, 'Doyck-Shin to all the delegates, members and friends who donated raffle items and sold tickets. Our next raffle will

In the past four years, through her leadership, the Washington Chapter student scholarship program was revived, developed and put in operation. At the May 7, 2009 meeting members voted unanimously to name one of the awards the “Carolyn Sue Clark Scholarship.” Sue was a dedicated member of ANS Camp 36 and the Seattle Cape Fox Dance Group. Recently she returned to college and planned to complete a degree. She held a black belt degree in Tae Kwon Do. Sue was known for her great love of family and for her pet cats. Her mother **Jackie Clark** is a well-known Tlingit and Haida Delegate and San Francisco Community Council President.

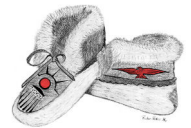
