## PRIORITIES FOR ENROLLMENT

- Income Eligible
- Age-Eligible Children
- Homeless families
- Teen Parents/Foster Parents
- Single Parent
- Alaska Native/American Indian Children
- Families with Challenging Needs or Circumstances

All families are encouraged to apply -- including over-income and non-native families.

## DISABILITY SERVICES

Families with children who have diagnosed or suspected disabilities are encouraged to apply. Disabilities may include, but are not restricted to: Speech, Health, Visual, Hearing, Behavioral Challenges or Physical Impairments.

## STEPS TO APPLY

1. Complete Eligibility Application (income must be listed.)
2. Child's original Birth Certificate. This will be returned immediately.
3. Income Verification for family such as: W-2 forms, IRS form, 1040 for the previous calendar year, last two pay stubs, ATAP/TANF printout, unemployment letter, SSI, dividends.
4. Child's current Immunization Record.
5. Tuberculosis Test Results.
6. Physical Exam or date scheduled.
7. Dental Exam or date scheduled.

Congratulations! When these have been received, your child is placed on the wait list and you will be notified about your child's eligibility. Enrollment determination will begin in the summer and continue until we have full enrollment.
