- Turn right onto N Northgate Way
- Turn left onto Meridian Avenue N, which becomes College Way N

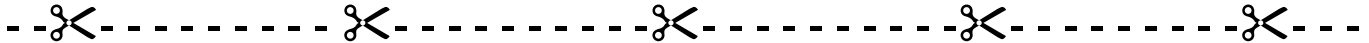
