Title: Support for the United Tribes of Bristol Bay and Clean Water

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 30,000 tribal citizens; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida supports the choice to live a subsistence life style; and

WHEREAS, subsistence lifestyles are at risk with mine development in Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the United Tribes of Bristol Bay (UTBB) is a consortium of 15 tribes in the Bristol Bay region that is advocating for the protection of tribal lands, water and cultures that is at risk by a mining project that has identified 3,190.55 acres of wetlands and other waters to be filled at the mining site; and

WHEREAS, clean water is life, and our Alaska water systems are at risk from massive mining projects; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe supports those who choose to live a healthy subsistence lifestyle;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Eighty-Third Tribal Assembly of Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened in Juneau, Alaska on April 18-20, 2018, hereby supports the efforts of United Tribes of Bristol Bay, and their goal to maintain fisheries, wetlands, and their way of life.


