Resolution TA 18-33

Title: Recognition of California State Assembly Member, Todd Gloria

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 30,000 tribal citizens; and

WHEREAS, a distinguished citizen of the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska is Todd Gloria, the California State Assembly member for the 78th Assembly District, who is the Legislature's only enrolled tribal citizen; and

WHEREAS, Todd's father is David Gloria, his grandfather is Louis J. Gloria, and his Great grandfather is Melchoir Gloria from the Philippines and Lucy Kasko from Haines. Lucy Kasko was the daughter of James Kasko and Elsie Joseph of Haines; and

WHEREAS, Todd's grandfather Louis J. Gloria was a past member of the Board of Director of the Sealaska Corporation having served on the Board from 1979 to 1988. He was born in Juneau, Alaska and raised in Petersburg. Todd's father, David Gloria, was a resident of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, Todd's exemplary career in public service includes working for the County of San Diego's Health and Human Services Agency, community representative and district director for U.S. Congresswoman Susan Davis, and City of San Diego Housing Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, In 2008 Todd was elected to the San Diego City Council, and is credited with bringing thousands of affordable housing units to the City of San Diego as well as helping to reallocate the City's limited homelessness service funds towards results-oriented programs, led the development of the city's budget as the Budget and Government Efficiency Committee chair, and, during his two full terms on the City Council, Todd was selected by his peers to serve as City Council President for two terms and served as the City's Interim Mayor from August 2013 to March 2014 during which time he is credited for restoring the public's trust in city government; and

WHEREAS, in the Assembly, Todd has continued his advocacy for increased infrastructure investment and pragmatic and innovative solutions to housing and homelessness, and authored 13 bills enacted into law dealing with important issues such as election reform, housing solutions, and cutting government red tape for small businesses;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Eighty-Third Tribal Assembly of Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened in Juneau, Alaska on April 18-20, 2018, hereby recognized Todd Gloria for his accomplishments in public service and the honor he brings to his people and his Tribe; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Tribal Assembly directs the Tlingit & Haida President to develop a means of recognition to honor high achieving tribal citizens, and to award an appropriate honor with the gratitude of the Tribal Assembly to the Honorable Todd Gloria, as a distinguished citizen of the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska.

ADOPTED this 20th day of April 2018, by the Eighty-Third Tribal Assembly of Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska.
