Title: Reduction of Tlingit & Haida Carbon Footprint by Promotion of the Use of Reusable  
Drink Containers

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 30,000 tribal citizens; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida hosts a number of large events, and provides coffee and bottled water; and

WHEREAS, the cups and bottles from the water take up space in landfills; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida provides reusable cups or mugs at most of their functions;  
and

WHEREAS, climate change is real, and the Tribe should find proactive ways to cut down on our carbon footprint;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Eighty-Third Tribal Assembly of Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened in Juneau, Alaska on April 18-20, 2018, hereby supports reducing the Tribe's carbon footprint by encouraging reusable cups by reminding people to bring their water bottles or reusable coffee mugs/container.


