Title: High School Credit Recovery

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 31,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, obtaining a high school diploma creates opportunities for employment and continued education; and

WHEREAS, the graduation rates of tribal citizens improve with adequate support, and the Tribe supports education as a priority; and

WHEREAS, credit recovery services could assist a struggling high school student to obtain a high school diploma, and offer that individual opportunities in the community that they otherwise would have road blocks to;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Eighty-Fourth Tribal Assembly of the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened in Juneau, Alaska on April 10-12, 2019, that Tlingit & Haida shall study the potential for credit recovery services through its Cultural Heritage & Education department.

ADOPTED this 12th day of April 2019, by the Eighty-Fourth Tribal Assembly of the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska.
