Title: Support of Sitka Tribe of Alaska and Local Sitka Clan's efforts on Herring in the Sitka Area

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 31,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, Sitka Tribe of Alaska is the federally recognized tribal government for the Sitka area and is responsible for the health, safety, and culture for its more than 4,400 tribal citizens; and

WHEREAS, in addition to Sitka Tribe of Alaska - the Clans in Sitka, with the lead of the Kiks'adi Clan, add a positive effort to conserve herring by bringing our local Tlingit traditional aspects;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Eighty-Fourth Tribal Assembly of Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened in Juneau, Alaska on April 10-12, 2019, hereby continues to support Sitka Tribe of Alaska in their efforts on herring;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, support of Sitka Tribe of Alaska and Local Sitka Clan's efforts on Herring in the Sitka Area to ensure a reasonable opportunity and priority for meeting the Sitka Tribe of Alaska's Tribal Citizens nutritional and cultural needs.

ADOPTED this 11<sup>th</sup> day of April 2019, by the Eighty-Fourth Tribal Assembly of Central of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska.
