Resolution TA 19-30

Title: Executive Committee Elections

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 31,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, the authority and duties of the Tlingit & Haida President and vice presidents of the Executive Council are enumerated in its Constitution Article IX, Function of Officers; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida currently requires executive council candidates to file their intent to run ten days in advance of Tribal Assembly and information in addition to the person's name would be helpful for delegates to have in advance of Tribal Assembly; and


WHEREAS, it is common practice to include a resume for other positions within the organization that highlight a person's education, skills and ability, this should also be common practice for our Executive Council to highlight their education, skills and experience that qualify them to govern and provide oversight for our Tribe; and

WHEREAS, we benefit from having strong leadership in our Executive Council, we would like to have included with the candidate declaration a resume not to exceed two pages in length that highlights the candidate's skills; this is not considered a campaign flyer and will therefore not have text smaller than 10 pt font or pictures;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Eighty-Fourth Tribal Assembly of Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened in Juneau, Alaska on April 10-12, 2019, supports informed voters, and shall electronically distribute to delegates copies of resumes that are received with Executive Council candidate declarations as part of their delegate packets prior to Tribal Assembly.

ADOPTED this 11th day of April 2019, by the Eighty-Fourth Tribal Assembly of the Central Council of Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska.
