Resolution TA 23-14

Title: Establishment of a SEARHC Geriatric Program in Southeast Alaska

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 35,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, SouthEast Alaska Regional Health Consortium (SEARHC) does not currently provide hearing aids or eye glasses to beneficiaries without health insurance; and

WHEREAS, many of our lifeways and the jobs in Alaska that our tribal citizens do are dangerous if the employee cannot hear or see well; and

WHEREAS, SEARHC paying for some or all of a beneficiary's hearing aids and eye glasses would make their work and life much safer; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida appreciates the services provided by SEARHC at all their facilities, however, this gaping hole by requiring beneficiaries to have health insurance to pay for hearing aids and eye glasses must be addressed;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Eighty-Eighth Tribal Assembly of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened April 19-21, 2023, hereby supports the establishment by the SouthEast Alaska Regional Health Consortium (SEARHC) of a new geriatric program in Southeast Alaska, with a doctor who specializes in geriatric services with the help of a geriatric trained case manager and a secretary.

ADOPTED this 19<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2023, by the Eighty-Eighth Tribal Assembly of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska.
