WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 32,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida has an active tribal court; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has an Alaska Court System webpage that lists tribal courts available in the state of Alaska; and


WHEREAS, the State of California has a court system webpage that lists tribal courts available in the state of California; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has been working in collaboration with the State of Alaska on other projects, such as education, and having our Tribal Court listed with links to the Tribe's pages would help identify resources for tribal citizens who may not have considered tribal courts as a resource available to them;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Eighty-Fifth Tribal Assembly of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska convened on October 1, 2020, hereby supports working with the State of Alaska to develop a tribal court directory.


